2010 Eventing Derby Day: September 12th

****Please pre-register; closing date: postmarked Sept. 3, or received in hand by Sept. 6th****

This is our 5th year of presenting casual and fun shows for the central Ohio Dressage Community. Come join us for a relaxed atmosphere and affordable shows.

Remember to save your tests because dressage scores count for *ODS year end and *MODA recognized

Eventing Derby Classes combine both a dressage and a jumping test. Dressage will be recognized USDF or USEA (United States Eventing Association) test. The jumping phase, or test, is a course of 7-9 jumping efforts containing both stadium-type jumps (painted standards and poles) as well as cross-country jumps. The cross-country jumps will incorporate natural components (logs, straw/hay bales) such as you might encounter on an easy trail ride – *no in-and-outs or water*. The jumping phase will be held in an enclosed 4-board fence around 5 acres, all jumps will be inviting and encouraging to both horse and rider.

Classes may be combined or divided (adult/youth) as entries warrant.

Safety: MANDATORY *ASTM/SEI* HELMET with securely fastened chin strap. Vests recommended. PLEASE LEAVE DOGS AT HOME. Large OPEN grassy areas to warm up.

Eventing Derby Classes are scored on a *penalty* basis. Dressage percentage scores are converted to penalty points (*the higher the percentage in the dressage phase, the lower the penalty points in a ride scoring 60% will be converted to 40 penalty points*). This score will be added to penalties accrued on the jumping test and the horse/rider combination with the lowest penalty score will win the Eventing Derby.

Jumping penalties: 5 penalties will accrue for first refusal, 10 penalties for the second. Further attempts at the obstacle may be made with or without help or the rider may opt to skip the obstacle and proceed to the next but *third attempts or go-arounds eliminate the horse/rider team from ribbon contention*. There will be no time limit or time penalties for this phase.

class 1: USDF Intro A, ground poles class 2: USDF Intro B, max jump height 18”

class 3: USEF Beg. Nov. Test A, max jump height 18” (may not compete in classes 1 or 2)

At the end of each class, additional jumping schools pre-purchased by entrants for \$10.00/round (see entry form) will run. Horse/Rider combinations that did not compete in the Derby but would like to school are welcome and will be allowed to school after Derby entrants have completed their schooling. These rounds may be pre-purchased on the entry form for \$20.00 or purchased through the show secretary on the day.

Dressage only Classes – all dressage classes will be in short ring
